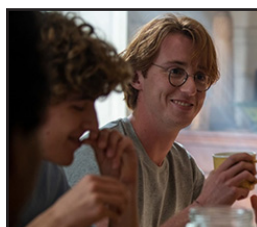

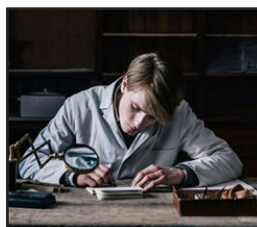
The Test

Karaoke

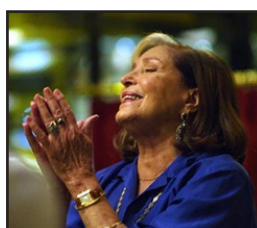
A bittersweet comedy about a husband and wife who are drawn to their charismatic neighbor who hosts Karaoke nights in his home.

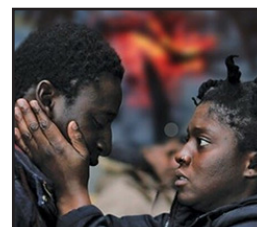
Rose

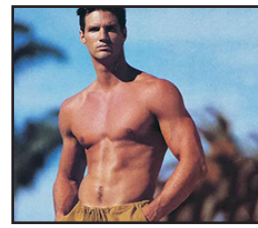

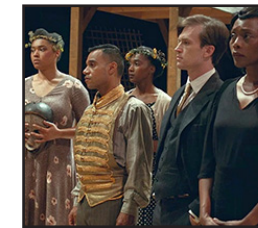
